



Thank You for Your Interest in Volunteering at International Festival '18

IFest is a HUGE undertaking, and there's only a handful of staff who plan and organize everything. So when the festival is actually here, we count on volunteers to help us actually pull off the event. We absolutely couldn't do it without you. We need for all volunteers to commit to work at least one entire shift - most of which are 3 or 4 hours. And we *hope* you'll do more than one, if possible. Volunteer times are available Friday, October 6 (for set up) & Saturday, October 7 for the festival. **All total, we have about 250 shifts to be covered by volunteers!**

Volunteer Rules & Regulations

By submitting an International Festival Volunteer Application, you agree to the following details and conditions:

- We depend on the faithfulness of our volunteers to make IFest a fun & organized event for all who attend. Please help us make it that way by only volunteering if you can commit to fulfilling your assigned duties. We understand that occasionally some unforeseen circumstance may arise. Please let us know ASAP if you will be unable to fulfill your position to so we can try to find a replacement.
- In order to be a volunteer, you must be **14 years** or older.
- Please don't bring anyone to accompany you during your volunteer shift. (If you have a friend who wants to hang out with you, make sure they **ALSO** signed up as a volunteer. We need them!)
- We do not accept walk-up volunteers - everyone must be registered in advance.
- Show up 15-20 minutes early to your shift. The area you're serving in may be a few minutes from volunteer check-in.
- Shifts listed are "approximate" times. A shift could possibly end a little earlier, and some a little later.
- All shifts are rain or shine. (We're hoping "shine.")
- Check in and out of each shift at Volunteer check-in.
- Complete all tasks given to you within your shift - and never leave your "station" unattended. If an emergency should arrive, please let someone know.
- Come prepared - you might want to bring a hat & sunscreen.
- Absolutely no drinking alcohol while on volunteer duty. If your shift is over, and you decide to have a beer (for our volunteers who are 21 and over), please change out of your volunteer t-shirt.
- We make every attempt to assign volunteers where they want to be, but this is not always possible. Please be flexible.
- After receiving your form, the Volunteer Coordinator will notify you by email of your actual assigned working shift and tasks. You will also get information on where to park and where to report for your shift. Please check your email - we have over 200 volunteers, so we can't possibly call everyone.
- Have fun while on duty! And keep a smile on your face!

IFest Volunteer Jobs

Listed below are the available volunteer positions. Please select your top three choices - 1, 2, 3. We will try our best to match you up with your first choice, but it may not be possible if EVERYONE wants the same job.

- ___ **Wherever You Need Me (boy do we love you!)**
- ___ Set Up (assisting vendors unload their vehicles & moving items to their tents, placing tables/chairs, etc)
- ___ Break Down (assisting vendors load up their vehicles, breaking down tables/chairs, etc)
- ___ Food Court Host/Hostess (helping keep the tables in the food court clean & wiped down)
- ___ Information Kiosk/Greeter (answer questions, give out programs, etc. - 2 people at each of 4 locations)
- ___ Currency Exchange (selling food coupons - involves handling money - **must be 18+ years old**)
- ___ International Kids Zone (assisting with making crafts)
- ___ Sports Zone (assisting people with playing games/maintaining the area)
- ___ "Where Are You From" Map (greeting visitors & asking them to put a star on a large map)
- ___ Avenue of Nations Trivia (telling visitors about the game/checking their finished paperwork/giving out prizes)
- ___ Floaters ("job hopper" - may be in Sports Zone for an hour, then move to Kids Zone, etc.)
- ___ Parade Marshal (assisting with organization and marking off parade route)
