

2015 Annual Summary of Misconduct Allegations
CALEA Standard 52.1.5

The Spartanburg Police Department's Office of Professional Standards & Inspections (OPSI) is tasked with investigating allegations of misconduct, inappropriate behavior, officer involved shootings, and any other situations of importance that warrant a thorough and objective investigation. Investigations are categorized as either a *Citizen Complaint* or an *Internal Complaint*. Based on the investigative findings; one of the following dispositions will be assigned to cases:

1. **Exonerated**: Incident occurred, but actions were lawful and proper.
2. **Sustained**: The allegation did occur.
3. **Not Sustained**: Insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegations.
4. **Policy Failure**: The allegation is true, but investigation reveals police or procedural changes are necessary.
