No person shall maintain chickens or a chicken coop unless granted a permit by the City. The permit shall be subject to all terms and conditions of Sec. 4-14 of the Code of the City of Spartanburg and any conditions deemed necessary by the City to limit the potential adverse impacts on the neighborhood surrounding the property on which the chickens are kept.

The chicken coop must be located at least 50 feet from the nearest residence other than that of the owner. No coop shall be placed in a front or side yard.

The owner must also obtain written approval of the keeping of chickens from all abutting property owners.

A permit to keep domesticated female chickens may be suspended or revoked by the City where there is a risk to public health or safety or for any violation of or failure to comply with any of the provisions of any other applicable ordinance or law. Any denial, revocation or suspension of a permit shall be in writing and shall include notification of the right to and procedure for appeal.

Permits are issued annually and are subject to any ordinance revisions adopted by Council. Should Council amend the Ordinance to prevent domesticated female chickens or any other new conditions, such amendment would apply to current permits within thirty (30) days from the date of adoption of Council's revisions.
