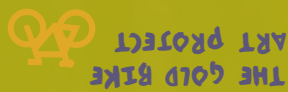

The first phase of the trail begins in the Grain District and heads toward the Chapman Cultural Center along Main Street, then North Liberty Street. The Music Trail cements Spartanburg's legacy as a place as a birthplace of American roots music—in particular, blues, jazz, country, gospel and bluegrass. EXPERIENCE DOWNTOWN SPARTANBURG

In this unique Southern city, creative energy and progressive growth blend with historic small-town charm. ASSAULT ON MT. MITCHELL ASSAULT ON MARION

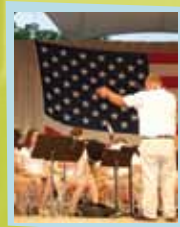
Monday, May 16, 6:30am (Race Start)

Borrow a bicycle through the Hub Cycle Program brought to you by Partners for Active Living.

Bicycles of Hub Cycle can be borrowed for a period of up to 3 months and a helmet and lock are included with each bike. A \$15 deposit is required and will be returned in full when the bike is returned. To borrow a Hub Cycle bike, the borrower must be 18 years of age or older, must sign the waiver and release, must agree to wear a helmet every time they ride, and must pay the refundable deposit amount.
