What's Spring Fling all About?

Spring Fling is more than just your average street fest - it's music, arts, crafts, food, children's activities, & special attractions galore. **Entertainment** abounds as five festival stages feature dozens of local, regional, and national entertainers. A **Food Court** with 35 concessionaires offers everything from crab cakes to funnel cakes. The **MarketPlace** presents a shopper lovers' paradise as more than 100 booths offer unique and one of a kind items for sale (vendors from 13 states were represented in 2011). The **Community Showcase** area features local non-profits sharing their message & garnering support from a large audience. There's a HUGE **Family Fun Zone** with rides, inflatables and tons of wallet-friendly activities. **The Underground** is a destination for young people to enjoy music, gaming, and other cool activities. Special Attractions include a **Professional Bicycle Race**, **Classic Car Show**, **Frisbee Dog Shows**, a **Cornhole Tournament**, and much more! Spring Fling is also a perfect opportunity for local businesses to gain exposure and/or sell their goods.

A Little History

Spring Fling began in 1979 as "an opportunity to get people out after being boxed up all winter" and to bring people back downtown. The first weekend in May was selected as the date for the festival. The festival had a budget of about \$5,000 and was one day. Downtown merchants fell into the swing of things by taking to the sidewalks with special values on merchandise. The first Spring Fling was labeled as "a frolicsome success!" 2012 marks the 34th year for Spring Fling.

When is Spring Fling?

The festival is always the first full weekend in May. This year's dates & hours are: Friday, May 4: 6 pm - 10 pm; Saturday, May 5: 11 am - 9 pm; Sunday, May 6: 1 pm - 7 pm

Attendance

Spring Fling hosts tens of thousands of people annually during the three-day event. An estimated 75,000 people converge on the streets of Downtown Spartanburg to celebrate this annual rite of Spring! While Spartanburg County residents make up the largest group of people attending the festival, visitors from all over the Upstate enjoy the festival.





Community Showcase Application (Non-Profits)

Dear Community Showcase Exhibitor:

You are invited to submit an application for the 2012 Spring Fling festival. It is scheduled for the first weekend in May in downtown Spartanburg, South Carolina. The Community Showcase area of the festival is lined with many of our local non-profit organizations in town. Examples of past year's participants include League of Women's Voters, Carolina Bassett Hound, Upstate PRIDE SC, Charles Lee Center, Children's Shelter of the Upstate, Hub City Farmer's Market, Hands for Soldiers, Mid-Atlantic Great Dane Rescue, Hope House, Greater Spartanburg Ministries, and many more.

Spring Fling is a perfect opportunity for you to showcase your organization and let the entire Upstate community know about you. Thousands and thousands of festival goers will walk past your exhibit over the course of the two days you will have your exhibit displayed. Some Community Showcase Exhibitors use the festival as an opportunity to raise funds by selling baked goods, bumper stickers, t-shirts, and other small items. Our Community Showcase vendors are placed right in the middle of all the action - after all, we all know that location, location, location is everything. (Spring Fling is actually a 3-day festival, but the Community Showcase area is not opened on Friday.)

Application Deadlines and Fees:

- **Applications are due March 23, 2012.** After this date, applications will still be accepted (if space is available) but the fees will increase.
- **\$15 non-refundable application fee**

April 4: Deadline for cancellation to receive booth fee refund minus \$50. **No refunds after this date.**

SPRING FLING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

What Can Community Showcase Vendors Do At Spring Fling?

Local non-profits primarily display information about their organizations. You are allowed to sell small “trinket” type items, bumper stickers, key chains, etc. in your booth. You can also sell baked goods. Community Showcase Vendors **ARE NOT ALLOWED to sell food (other than baked goods), soft drinks or water.** Nor are you allowed to give away bottles of water - beverage vendors pay alot of money to sell at Spring Fling. Spring Fling also sells water to help pay for the event. (Giving away a small cup of water or something similar would be allowed.)

Application Deadline and Fee

Although the deadline for applications is March 23, booth space fills up quickly. All Spring Fling Applications must be accompanied by a \$15 non refundable application fee. **Should vendor not be accepted, all fees (minus the application fee) will be returned promptly.**

WE ARE SMOKE FREE

Spring Fling is a SMOKE-FREE event. (As of September 1, 2011, ALL city events are smoke-free.) Exhibitors are not allowed to smoke inside their booth space. Smoking is only allowed outside the perimeters of the Spring Fling footprint.

RAIN OR SHINE EVENT

Spring Fling is a rain or shine event. No refunds will be made in the event of rain. Exhibitors are responsible for their own booth’s rain protection. If inclement weather becomes too severe, the Spring Fling Committee will be responsible for making the final determination on the continuance of the event.

TAXES & FEES

The City of Spartanburg does not require Spring Fling vendors to purchase a Business License (the fee you pay to participate in the festival is in lieu of a Business License.)

BOOTH SPACE

Spring Fling provides space only. All set-up is the responsibility of exhibitors, including tents, tables, chairs, etc. **All tents must be firmly secured with a minimum of 50 lbs. weighted per pole.** (More information will be provided in the confirmation package mailed out prior to the festival.)

VENDOR PARKING

Spring Fling does not offer reserved vendor parking. There is however, parking in the Downtown Spartanburg area around the festival site. **Power hook-ups are not provided** in any parking areas, or for any storage vehicles on or off-site. If you have a supply vehicle that will require power, you must bring your own generator.

BREACH OF POLICIES

Spring Fling may, at its election, terminate the Policies, Procedures and Requirements Agreement between Spring Fling and the vendor at any time upon breach of these policies and the accompanying contract. Upon termination, Spring Fling may choose to retain any booth rental fees paid by the vendor.

**WAIVER, RELEASE & INDEMNITY

The undersigned also understands that if any of the event policies are violated that they will forfeit their fees paid to participate in the festival. The undersigned understands that Spring Fling staff and executive volunteers are responsible for making final decisions with regard to the event operations and agrees to abide by their decisions. By its signature, vendor agrees to release, hold harmless the City of Spartanburg, its staff, agents and employees from any damages including loss of life sustained even if liability arises out of the negligence of the City of Spartanburg, its staff, agents and employees.

Vendor further agrees to defend and indemnify the City of Spartanburg, its staff, agents and employees, from any and all claims. The undersigned further acknowledges and agrees that this Release and Indemnity shall be construed to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law and that if any provision or portion of this Release and Indemnity is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the undersigned agrees that the remainder of this Release and Indemnity shall remain in full force.

Vendor further understands that I have given up substantial rights by signing this Waiver and Release and sign it voluntarily. This Waiver and Release also binds my heirs and assigns.
