Disposal of construction and  
demolition debris

In the past the City of Spartanburg hauled residential construction and demolition debris. Due to policy changes at the Spartanburg County landfill, the City can no longer haul construction and demolition debris. The residents are now responsible for the transport and disposal of any construction or demolition debris. Spartanburg County Landfill located at Wellford, SC will accept these materials at a charge for disposal.

Construction and demolition debris includes, but is not limited to, the following items: construction debris removed from both inside and outside the residence. Examples are building materials such as, shingles, wood, carpet and padding, commodes, sinks, bath tubs and shower enclosures, cabinets, storage buildings, wood & vinyl fences, landscape timbers, cross ties, windows, doors, etc.

## Disposal of tires

The City of Spartanburg has never had a policy for picking up tires generated by the residents. The residents of the City of Spartanburg may take five tires a day (if generated by the resident) to the landfill at no charge.

If the City had a policy for hauling residential tires, then there would be a charge of \$74.00 a ton for disposal of tires transported by the City. This fee is beyond the taxes paid for landfill credits.

Therefore, it continues to be the responsibility of the resident to dispose of tires at the landfill.
