**Mr. Story** reviewed the ordinance with Council. Discussion was held. Council asked that a sentence be added to require City Bus riders to wear masks. Masks will be provided to bus riders. Council asked that a provision be added to make the ordinance effective at 12:01 p.m. on Monday, June 29, 2020. Councilmembers Smith and Brown stated that they would prefer immediate effectiveness, but, that they would vote in support of the 12:01 p.m. Monday, June 29, 2020 effectiveness of the ordinance.

***Councilmember Rice** made a motion to approve the emergency ordinance as discussed. Mayor pro tem Littlejohn seconded the motion, which carried unanimously 7 to 0.*
