The proposal is for petitioner to have a wood fence 6' high from front corner of the house and around the backyard. From the front corner to the street would start at 6' in one section and end in 3' with remainder to sidewalk 3' to allow visibility of the road from the driveway, from Petra Brooks, Property Owner.
