

**NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILIBLTY**  
**Community Development Block Grant Program-CV3 - CARES Act**

The City of Spartanburg announces the availability of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV3) funds to undertake projects to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus (COVID-19). The City of Spartanburg is an Entitlement Jurisdiction and receives CDBG funds on a formula basis from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to fund activities that primarily benefit low and moderate-income (LMI) residents of the City of Spartanburg.

Requests involving federal funds must serve LMI areas or persons in the City of Spartanburg. All funding request applications for CDBG-CV3 must be submitted to and received by the Neighborhood Services Department by Friday, January 15, 2020 at 4:00 PM. Applications and additional information can be found at the City of Spartanburg Neighborhood Services website at <https://www.cityofspartanburg.org/community-services/neighborhood-services> and a copy of the application can be requested for pick up in the Neighborhood Services Department at 440 S. Church Street, Suite B, weekdays, between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM.

Public Hearings on recommendations for Funding Allocations for CDBG-CV3 will be held in January. Awards are to be made after approval from the City of Spartanburg Council and HUD.
